







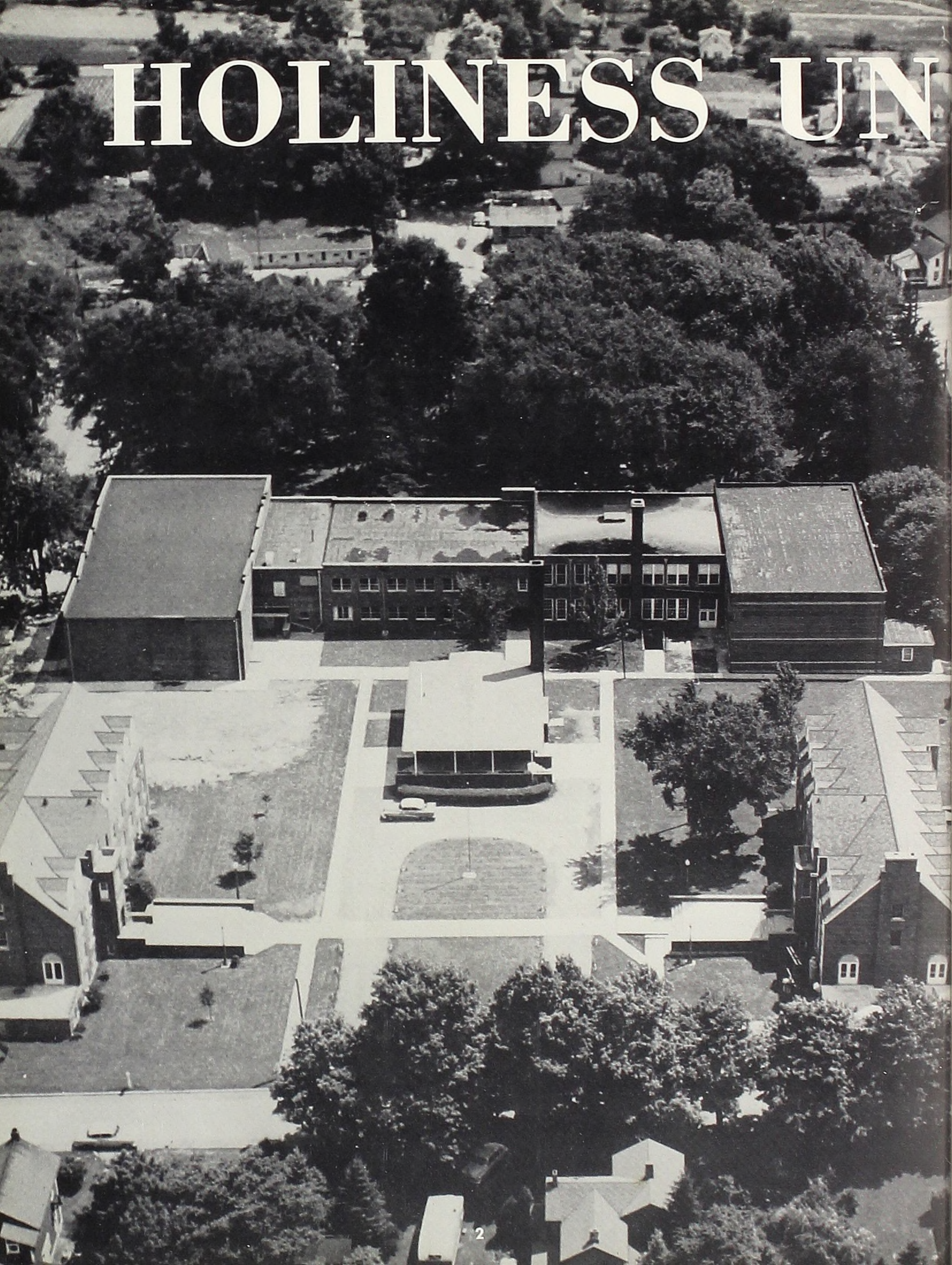

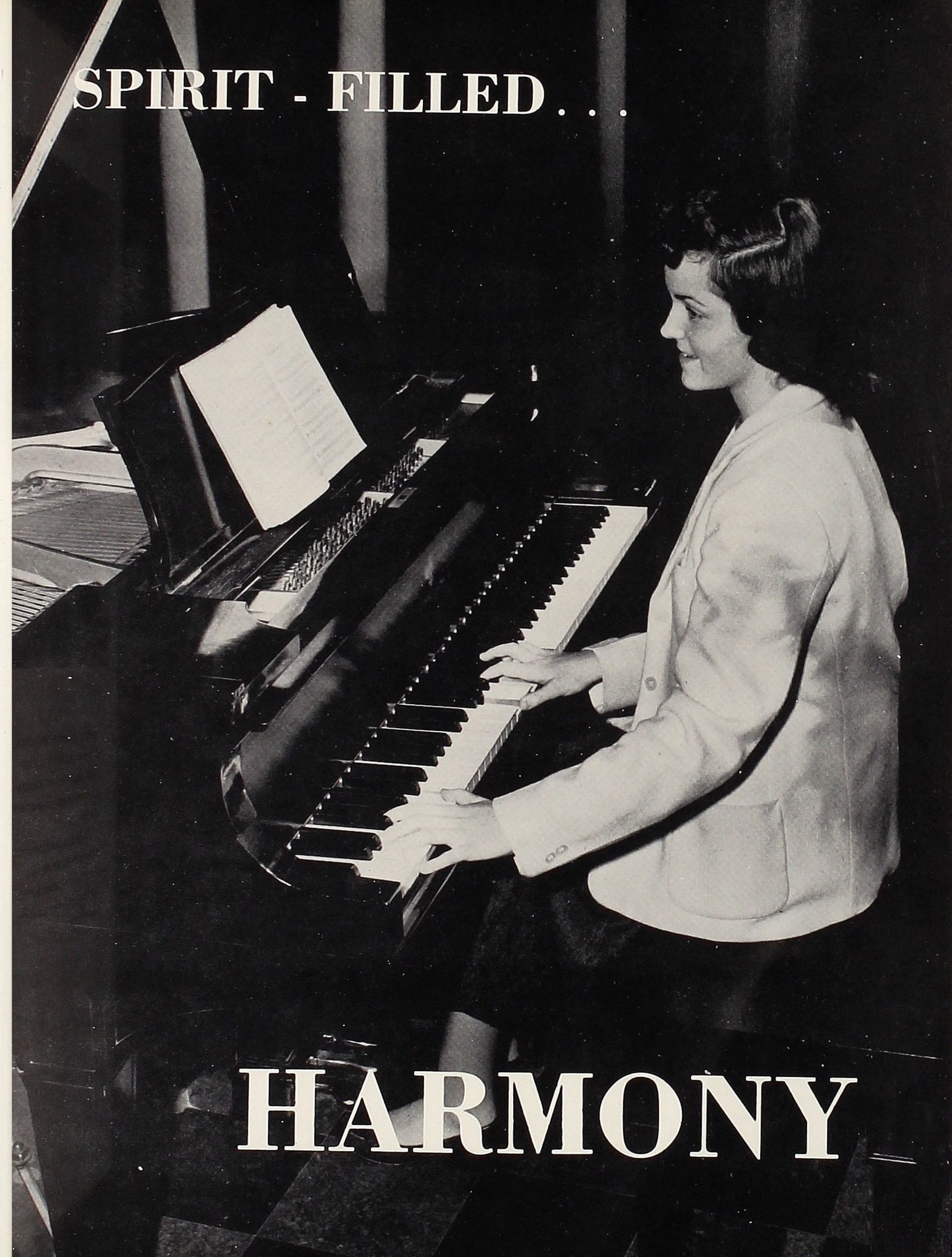
In appreciation for your true Christ-like spirit, sincerity, and helpfulness shown to all, we would like to dedicate this Echo to you, Dr. McKenna.

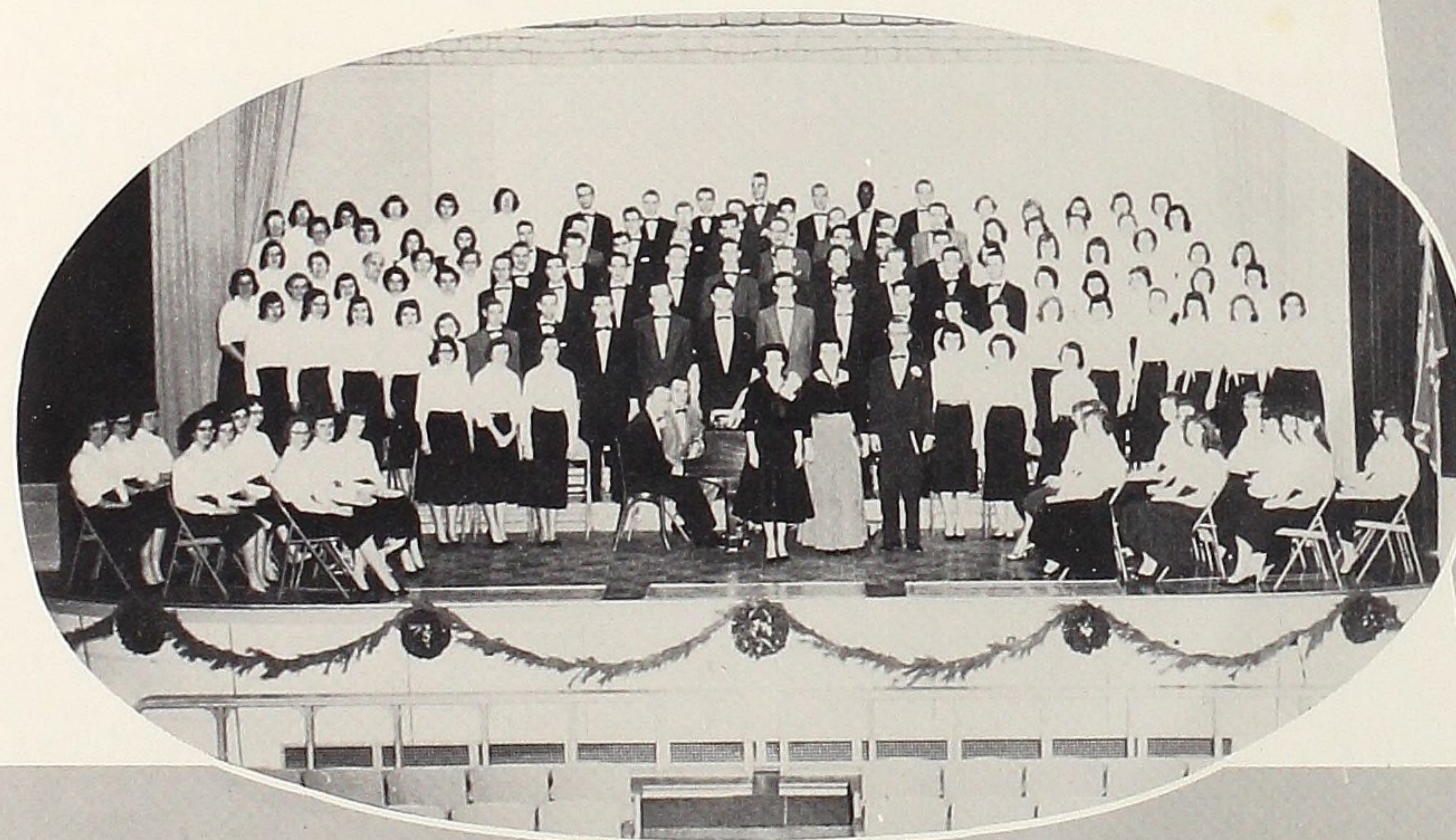

The team compiled a (7-1) record with double victories over Leslie, Jackson St. Mary, and Morenci preceded by a split with Pittsford. The affirmative was debated by Mark Mason and Joyce Andrews with Dorothy Eagle as reserve; those taking the negative side were Howard Snyder and Wesley Hetrick with John Hunt, reserve.

The team then entered tournaments and continued to meet with success. They competed in the regional at Homer and came through victorious, downing Jackson St. Mary, Kalamazoo Christian, and Homer. Mark Mason and Howard Snyder represented Spring Arbor in tournament play. The state quarter final at Ovid saw Spring Arbor winning over Ovid and, by drawing a semi-final bye, the team was destined for the University of Michigan on April 19 to compete in the Michigan State C-D Finals.

The debate squad has received many honors for their outstanding achievements. The Regional victory entitled them to a banner from the University of Michigan and a plaque from the Detroit Free Press. The University of Michigan also presented a large bronze trophy and each of the debaters received gold watches for reaching the state final.

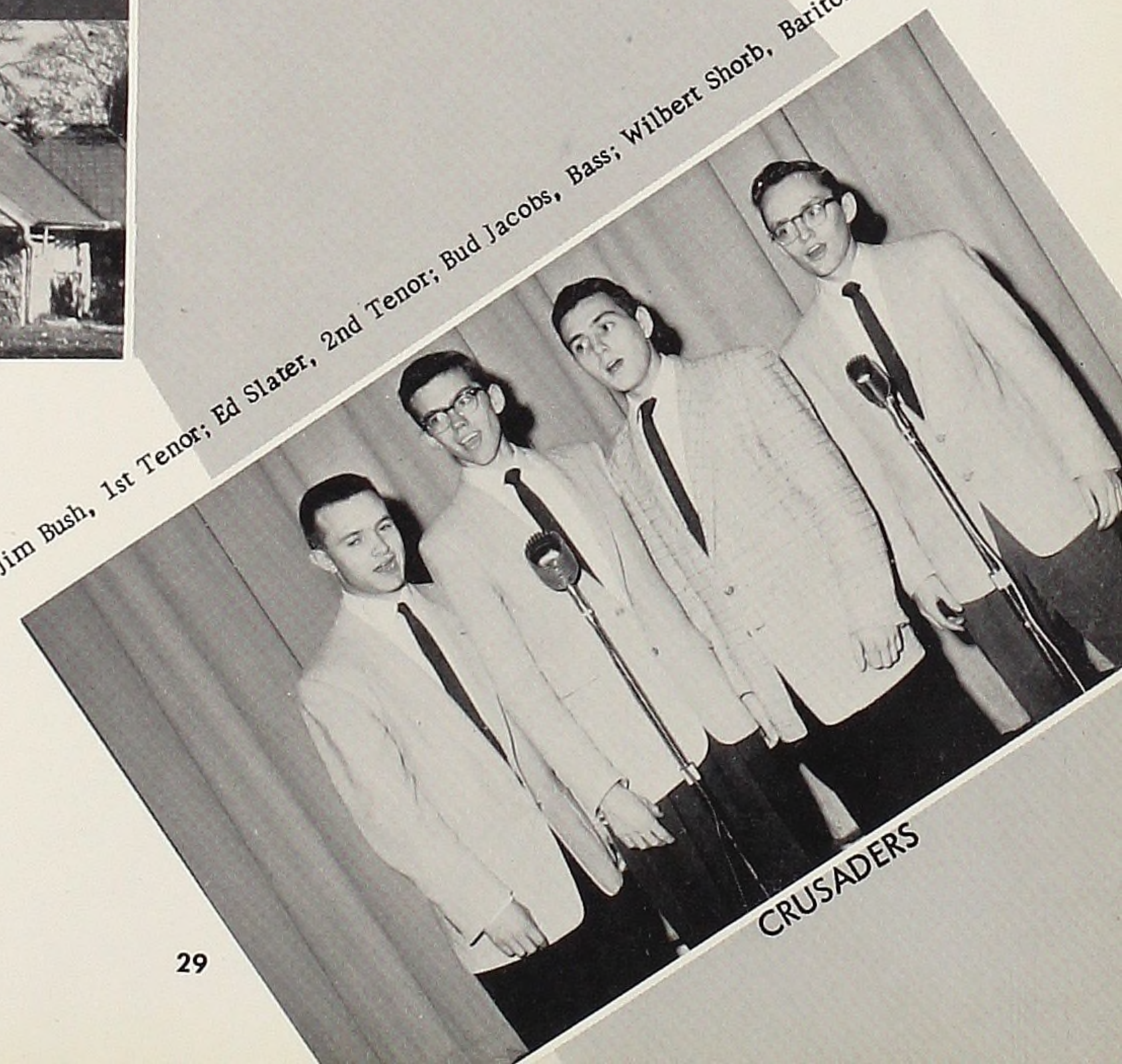
### Our Pastor
